**ORDER IMPLEMENTING MATTERS RE ENTRY OF A
PROCEDURAL ORDER AND CASE MANAGEMENT PLAN
IN THE MEMBERSHIP PHASE OF THESE PROCEEDINGS
DISCUSSED AT A CONFERENCE HELD ON JANUARY 17, 2003**

THIS MATTER comes before the Court concerning implementation of matters discussed
at a conference held on January 17, 2003 in connection with the adoption of a Procedural Order

and Case Management Plan pertaining to Section 1 of the Hydrographic Survey relating to the Membership Phase of this proceeding and the Court being sufficiently advised in the premises:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Counsel for the State and Julia Hosford Barnes, Esq., shall initially confer, meet and commence the coordination of their efforts on January 30, 2003 in order to draft a Procedural Order and Case Management Plan concerning the water rights claims of members of CID in the Membership Phase of these proceedings insofar as they pertain to Hydrographic Survey Section 1. The Honorable Vickie L. Gabin has agreed to participate in the preparation of the procedural order and case management plan to the extent that her schedule conveniently permits such participation.
2. Efforts to prepare a Procedural Order and Case Management Plan shall be implemented in connection with Hydrographic Survey Section 2 commencing thirty (30) days after the publication of Hydrographic Survey Section 2.
3. Efforts to determine and adjudicate water rights in connection with Hydrographic Survey Sections 1 and 2 will be coordinated and proceed simultaneously to the extent reasonably feasible.
4. The proposed Procedural Order and Case Management Plan as to Hydrographic Survey Section 1 shall be submitted to the Court for review and consideration as expeditiously as possible, and, in any event, on or before March 28, 2003. If necessary, a hearing for the review, approval and entry of the Procedural and Case Management Plan and any other related matters that may be properly brought before the Court in connection with Hydrographic Survey Section 1 shall be held


on April 11, 2003 if the Court determines that such a hearing is required. If the Court determines that a hearing should be held on April 11, 2003, the Court will set a time and place for such a hearing.
