**ORDER SETTING ADJUDICATION WIDE
STATUS AND SCHEDULING CONFERENCE**

Pursuant to Rules 16 and 53 of the New Mexico Rules of Civil Procedure for District Courts, the Special Master will conduct an adjudication wide status and scheduling conference on Tuesday, April 13, 2004, commencing at 10:00 am, at the Chavez County Commission Room, No. 1 St Mary's Place, Roswell, New Mexico.

1. The following matters will be considered at the status and scheduling conference:

A. The work plan of the State of New Mexico, ex rel. State Engineer, (the "State") for completing this adjudication, including, without limitation:

- A discussion of the Non-Indian Adjudication Work Plan (insofar as it pertains to the Pecos) that appears as Appendix D to the 2003 State Water Plan, available at <http://www.seo.state.nm.us/hot-topics/index.html>

- Any anticipated amendments or modifications to that plan
- Prioritization of work, budgeting, staffing and other assumptions upon which the work plan is predicated

B. For Each Hydrographic Survey Section of this adjudication (except the Gallinas, for which a separate Status and Scheduling Conference will be set):

- The present status of the adjudication
- The (i) adequacy of any procedural or scheduling orders now in place and (ii) possible amendments to those orders
- The identification of all motions, contested matters or other issues pending before the Court
- The identification of any motions, contested matters or other issues likely to be presented to the Court within the next six months


C. The Data Management System for this adjudication to be implemented by the Special Master, including:

- The goals and purpose of the system
- The manner of implementing the system


D. The parties' suggestions for improved judicial management of the adjudication.
