Shiprock-San Juan Project Conference Washington, D. C.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Navajo Tribe, the Chairman of the Tribal Resources Committee, and a member of the Advisory Committee from the Shiprock area as may be designated by the Chairman, be and they are hereby authorized to proceed to Washington, D. C., to represent the Tribe in the conference called by the Secretary of the Interior on March 27, 1951, to consider plans for the fuller utilization of the San Juan River or irrigating lands of the river, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenses of said representatives of the Tribe in making said trip shall be paid from Tribal funds.
