

## **ORDER**

THE ABOVE MATTER coming on for hearing on the Court's own Motion during a scheduled Status Conference Hearing May 24, 2004, in the San Juan County Court House, Farmington, New Mexico, after notice of the hearing having been sent to all parties on the Court's Docket Sheet, by the Clerk of the Court, and the Court having found good cause to impose the time limitations set out below, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED

1. THAT the Office of the State Engineer shall commence hydrographic surveys and initiate subfile proceedings in accordance with its Second Amended Plan for Administrative Development to Complete the San Juan River Basin Adjudication;

The Office of the State Engineer shall provide to the Court, forthwith, the name of the river and or ditch and the approximate location upon which it will commence the application of its field work, and the approximate time in which sub-file number one will be opened;

The Office of the State Engineer will also file a statement with the Court on how it plans to join neighboring water users.

2. THAT the United States of America, by and through its duly assigned Federal Agencies, shall file a statement of all water claims with the Office of the State Engineer, with copies filed with the Clerk of this Court, no later then thirty (30) days from the date of the entry of this Order with the Clerk of the District Court. Each claim shall include the source of water, point(s) of diversion, priority of claim, place of use, quantity of water claimed to be approved by the Court, the legal basis for each claim, and the historical use of the water having heretofore been beneficially used;

3. THAT the Navajo Nation shall file with the Clerk of this Court, with the cooperation of the Interstate Stream Commission an informal status report regarding the progress of the Navajo Water Rights Settlement no later than six (6) months from the date of the entry of this Order. The Clerk of this Court will file the Report and forward copies to all parties on the Court's Docket Sheet;

4. THAT the Ute Mountain Nation shall file a statement of all water claims with the Office of the State Engineer, with copies filed with the Clerk of this Court, no later than thirty (30) days from the entry of this Order. The claim shall include the source of water, point(s) of diversion, priority of claim, place of use, quantity of water claimed to be approved by the Court, legal basis for each claim and the historical use of water having been heretofore beneficially used; and

4. THAT the content of this Order was discussed in open Court during the Status Conference
Hearing but the parties to whom the Order is directed have not had the opportunity to review or
register objections or comments on the written Order. Therefore, the parties to whom this
Order is directed have thirty (30) days from the entry thereof with the Clerk of the District Court
to register any comment or objection and/or request leave for argument.


