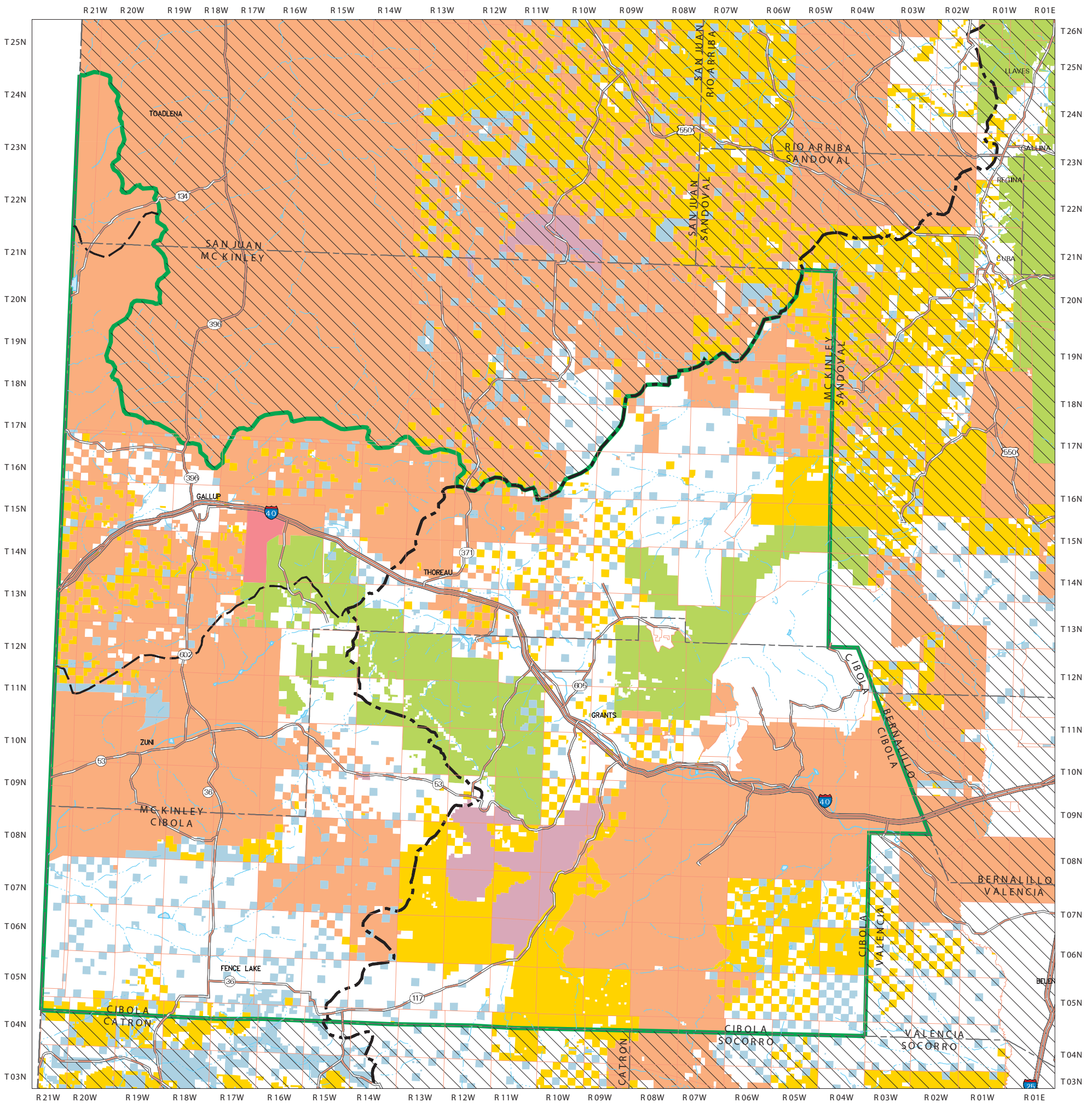


Cibola and McKinley Regional Water Plan Land Ownership in the Region

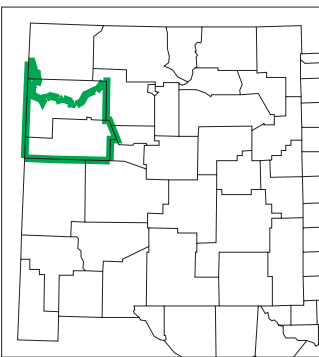

Compiled from digital data provided by the New Mexico Resource Geographic Information System (RGIS). Original base maps digitized from 1:500,000 mylar sheets and 100,000 paper maps for New Mexico. These data meets National Mapping Accuracy Standards for 1:500,000 and 1:100,000 scale maps. Land ownership coverage developed by the BLM at 1:100,000 scale. Boundary of the Cibola and McKinley Water Planning Region is based on county boundaries and surface drainage divides.

Horizontal accuracy: At the scale of 1:850,000 at least 90 percent of the points tested are within 1/30th inch (0.0333 inch), or within 758 ground meters, of their true location.

Projection: Universal Transverse Mercator, Zone 13, Units meters, NAD83.
