Context for this Meeting Announcement

Introduction - The Water Assembly and the Middle Rio Grande Council of Governments (MRGCOG) encourage your participation in planning our water future. Done together, water planning should result in an economically, hydrologically, socially, and environmentally sound long-term future for the region. There are a variety of ways to become involved – please join with us to make it happen.

The Process - The Water Assembly (WA) and the Middle Rio Grande Council of Governments are partnered in developing a Regional Water Plan for the Middle Rio Grande Region (Sandoval, Bernalillo, and Valencia Counties) through an open, inclusive and participatory process. Everyone is encouraged to attend and to fully take part in all meetings. The process is intended to be collaborative, bringing together all of the diverse regional interests so as to achieve a solution that is best for all. The resultant Regional Water Plan is intended both to solve regional issues and to be incorporated into a statewide water plan.

The Water Assembly - The Water Assembly is a grass-roots, all-volunteer organization dedicated to Regional Water Planning. It consists of Five Constituency Groups, Six Working Teams, Two Subregional Groups, an Action Committee, and an Executive Committee. In addition, there is an annual meeting of all participants. The Constituency Groups are charged with advocating their respective interests. The Working Teams are charged with performing key portions of the program in a balanced and objective way. The Subregional Groups are charged with the planning for their hydrologically separate areas. The Action Committee is charged with overseeing the effective operation of the process, and the Executive Committee is supports the Action Committee.

MRGCOG - The Middle Rio Grande Council of Governments is a state-chartered association of local governments and is headed by a Board of Directors with members from those governments. The MRGCOG Board has delegated authority for water planning to a Water Resources Board, made up of representatives from local governments in the three-county region. MRGCOG also has a paid staff supporting the water planning process.
